

Animal Nutrition Association of Canada Graduate Scholarship 2024

(Established 2004)

The Animal Nutrition Association of Canada (ANAC) is pleased to offer the ANAC Graduate Scholarship to university graduate students enrolled in Animal Science or a related field of study, with a specific interest in animal nutrition.

> Value: \$4,000 Number Awarded: 1 Deadline to Apply: March 1, 2024

Background: ANAC is the national trade association of the Canadian livestock feed industry. ANAC membership represents approximately 90% of animal feed products commercially manufactured in Canada. The ANAC Graduate Scholarship is made possible through funding from ANAC member companies. The intent of this scholarship is to encourage students to consider pursuing a career in the feed industry and to demonstrate ANAC's appreciation for the science of animal nutrition.

Criteria: Applicants must be:

- university graduate students enrolled in Animal Science or a related field of study, with a specific interest (research project/course selection) in animal nutrition
- Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada
- able to attend the Animal Nutrition Conference of Canada (ANCC) 2024 where they will give a short presentation on their research and their award will be presented (details outlined in the Award section below)

Application: Applications must be submitted electronically by March 1, 2024. The online application package includes the following elements to be submitted as one file (e.g. PDF format) in the listed order:

- 1. Resume
- 2. Reference letter from the applicant's academic advisor
- 3. One-page cover letter outlining their project and how it contributes to the Canadian feed industry **Note**: Commitment to attend the conference must be stated in the letter
- 4. Official transcript or list of completed courses signed by the applicant's academic advisor. Additional consideration will be given to those that have a focus on nutrition-related courses.

All application packages should be submitted electronically using this online form.

Selection Process: The Leadership Group of the ANAC Nutrition Committee will serve as the Selection Committee. The committee will review the applications and recommend a final applicant for approval by the ANAC Board of Directors. Preference may be given to applicants whose work shows higher potential for application toward improved performance/profitability/nutrition in the animal feed industry.



Award: The successful candidate will be notified prior to March 22, 2024. The scholarship will be presented at the ANCC in Winnipeg, Manitoba on May 14-16, 2024. The successful applicant will agree to attend this conference (registration, economy travel and accommodations paid for by ANAC) and deliver a 20-minute presentation (15-minute presentation + 5 minutes for questions) outlining their research and its applicability to the feed industry. A 250-word written abstract to be included in the conference Book of Abstracts and online Proceedings will also be required.
