

What are Category 1 Feeds

Imported and Domestic

- Standard mixed feeds
 - Complete feeds
 - Supplements
 - Macro- and micro-premixes
 - Mineral feeds
 - Converter feeds
- Simple mixtures of some single ingredient feeds
 - Those listed in categories 1-7

Why Streamline?

- The feed industry and producers will benefit from quicker access to these products
- There is no additional monetary cost for a streamline application

Exclusions

- Products with claims or additional voluntary guarantees on labels other than those allowed by RG-1 Chapter 4.12 - Permissible claims policy for livestock feed,
- 2. Imported medicated feeds
- 3. Free-choice mineralized salts and mineral feeds for ruminants containing added selenium
- 4. Feeds for mink, foxes, and fish other than salmonids

Normal and Streamline

- Application submitted to PASO
- Receives administrative review by PASO
- 3. Sent for technical pre-screen
- Accepted into the queue (or returned)
- Accepted applications enter the review queue
- 6. Reviewed when it reaches the top of the queue
- 7. Deficiencies communicated
- 8. Registered (or returned)

- Application submitted to PASO identifying their applications meet the streamline requirements
- 2. Receives administrative review by PASO
- 3. Sent directly for technical review
- 4. Registered (or returned)

Streamline Application Content

- Cover letter— indicating that this is a streamlined application
- Application Form
- Application Fee
- Streamline Checklist
- Label (3 copies)
- * For new and all imported feeds A complete list of ingredients named as per the Schedules IV/V
- * Calculations showing required nutrient guarantees are compliant with Table 4 minimums and maximums
- * If medicated calculations showing that the directions for use result in a medicated feed compliant with the CMIB

How to Submit

New Category 1 Streamline Applications

 At this time all feed applications including category 1 streamline applications must be submitted through the mail or by courier

Transitioning previously submitted applications:

- Applicants can choose to transition a Category 1 application currently in the queue awaiting review to the streamlined process
- Submit the required streamline documents to PASO (excluding the form and fees already in hand)
- Include the file reference number provided with the file was originally accepted
