This is a contract position, working out of the Clinton location. (Possibility of Hybrid/Remote). This is a one-year contract position.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Develop individualized animal nutrition plan (i.e., customized feed formulations) according to customer requirements.
- Interact with sales personnel regarding nutrition and health of animals.
- Responsible for feed budgets and cost analysis.
- Work closely with Feed Mill staff to improve efficiencies and ensure HACCP goals and CFIA requirements are met.
- Work closely with the purchasing group to assess the nutritional and economic value of feed ingredients.
- Research strategies and techniques to meet the needs of different animal species. This includes nutritional solutions for poultry, swine, ruminant, and other animals.
- Maintain feed formulas and feed formulation database (maintenance of ingredient nutrient matrix values; pricing; least cost formulation; labeling).
- All other duties assigned.
